

## 06 Days Ultimate Tanzania Safari.

### Day 1: Arrive in Arusha

Karibu Tanzania - Welcome to Tanzania. On arrival at the airport you will be met by one of our staff members. After greet and meet services he will escort you to your accommodation in Arusha (approximately 60 Km) ready for the safari tomorrow.

### Day 2: Arusha – Tarangire National Park

After breakfast at the hotel, check-out and drive to Tarangire National park.

Today you will spend the day game viewing in the park. Tarangire National Park is home to large herds of elephant and other game, including the elusive leopard and over 400 bird species. The parks picturesque landscape is dotted with large Baobab trees and gets its name from the Tarangire River that crosses through the park. During the dry season (from around August to October) the river is the only source of water for the animals.

In the late afternoon, drive to Manyara escarpment for overnight rest.

### Day 3: Drive to Serengeti National Park

After breakfast and check-out, you will be transferred to Serengeti National Park (approximately 4hrs drive). On arrival, enjoy a game drive en-route to your camp where lunch will be served. This particular camp lies right in the heart of central Serengeti. The spectacular and secluded location of this camp boasts all year-round game which choose to graze around the camp due to its lagoon type contoured landscape, where the camps is surrounded on three sides by water catchments. There will be time to relax before departing for an afternoon game drive in the park followed by dinner.

### Day 4: Serengeti National Park

Spend the next two days exploring the vast Serengeti plains. The name 'Serengeti' comes from the Maasai language and means 'endless place'. The vast open savannahs and wooded grasslands are home to large predators like lion, leopards, cheetahs, herds of buffalo, elephant, giraffe and also to a host of plains game and a wide variety of birdlife. The Serengeti/Ngorongoro Conservation area plays host to the Great Wildebeest Migration, which is one of the natural wonders of the animal world - millions of wildebeest and zebra migrate in a year round pattern through Tanzania and Kenya and in the early months of each year the short grass plains in this area provide the perfect setting for the calving season where hundreds of calves are born. All meals will be served at the camp today. *Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner included*

### Optional Tour: Hot Air Balloon Safari

---

You will have the option to take a Hot Air Balloon Safari (extra cost \$ 546 pp) which ends with a champagne breakfast served in the middle of the bush.

#### Day 5: Ngorongoro Crater

After breakfast at the lodge, you will drive and descend to the Ngorongoro Crater floor for full day game viewing. The Ngorongoro Crater is a World Heritage Site and is the home to a wide variety of animals. The Crater consists of a number of ecological environments, including grasslands, swamps, forests and even a soda lake. There is a wide variety of game like rhino, buffalo, wildebeest, zebra and an amazing variety of birdlife including thousands of migrating flamingos. Afterwards, you will ascend back to the rim of the crater in late afternoon and return to your lodge, arriving in time to freshen up before dinner. *Breakfast, Picnic Lunch and Dinner included*

#### Day 6: Ngorongoro– Arusha

After breakfast you will drive to JRO for your flight back home.  
*Breakfast and Packed Lunch included*
